EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 049 5.2022

### **RE-CONSTITUTION OF THE** PROVINCIAL MICRO, SMALL, AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT (MSMED) COUNCIL IN THE PROVINCE OF BILIRAN

WHEREAS, Sec. 20, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution affirms that the State recognizes the indispensable role of the private sector, encourages private enterprise, and provides incentives to needed investments;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides the participation of the private sector in local governance, particularly in the delivery of basic services, shall be encouraged to ensure the viability of local autonomy as an alternative strategy for sustainable;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 10644, which was signed into law on July 15, 2014, otherwise known as "Go Negosyo Act" seeks to strengthen local Micro, Small, and Medium and Enterprises (MSMEs) to create more job opportunities in the country;

WHEREAS, Section 03 of Republic Act 10644 inscribes the establishment of Negosyo Centers in all provinces, cities and municipalities responsible for promoting ease of doing business and facilitating access to services for MSMEs within its jurisdiction:

WHEREAS, to promote MSMEs and local entrepreneurship, the same DILG Memorandum Circular 2002-107 dated July 10, 2002 provides for the organization of the Provincial Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Development (MSMED) Council;

WHEREAS, to ensure overall implementation and management of the Negosyo Centers in the Province of Biliran; there is a need to re-constitute the Provincial MSMED Council as established in section 9 of RA10644 and as per recommendation letter dated July 22, 2022 from office of the OIC Provincial Director of the Department of Trade and Industry.

NOW, THEREFORE I, GERARD ROGER M. ESPINA, Governor of the Province of Biliran, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order.

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The Provincial Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Development (MSMED) Council of Biliran Province is hereby re-constituted and shall be composed of the following:

## SECTION 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and provide appropriate services beneficial to local enterprise and entrepreneurs.

The Provincial MSMED Council may consult advisory units in its regular meetings and other activities of the council. However, no voting rights shall be granted to the members of the Advisory Unit.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVITY.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
