



Executive Order No 2022 - 053

AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE ENHANCED COMPREHENSIVE LOCAL INTEGRATION PROGRAM COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall promote the welfare of all its constituents and declares that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessing of democracy;

WHEREAS, paragraph VIII-F of Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)-Department of National Defense (DND) Joint Memorandum, Circular No. 2018-01 dated July 5, 2018, mandates the creation of the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP) Committee at the Provincial Level;

WHEREAS, the E-CLIP in partnership with the local government (Province) provides financial/livelihood assistance to qualified former rebels and mainstreams them as productive citizens and partners in local development;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GERARD ROGER M. ESPINA, Governor of the Province of Biliran, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order to reorganize the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP) Committee of the Province of Biliran:

Section 1. Organization and Composition of the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program Committee. The Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program Committee is hereby organized and to be constituted as follows:

Section 2, Functions of the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program Committee. Pursuant to DILG-DND Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01, the E-CLIP shall have the following functions:

1. Ensure the convergent effort in the delivery of the identified services of the program;
2. Ensure proper documentation and referral of the needs of the Former Rebels (FRs) to appropriate agencies and other partner institutions including getting the profile of the FRs;
3. Facilitate the profiling of the FRs, through the Local Social Welfare and Development Office (LSWDO);
4. Assist the FR in completing the E-CLIP Enrolment Form. The FR should either sign or thumb mark the Form after completing it attested by the DILG Provincial Director and approved by the Provincial Governor or by his designated officer preferable the Provincial Administrator or LSWD Officer;
5. Assist the FR in the preparation of his/her Former Rebel Reintegration Plan (FRRP) and Business Plan, with the LSWDO as the lead agency to assist the FR. It shall have the option to come-up with its template (form) of FRRP and Business Plan, as long as the datasets reflected in the Sample Forms in Annexes E and F are considered;
6. Resolve issues and concerns affecting the implementation of the E-CLIP;
7. Provide the updates to Provincial Peace and Order Council during its meetings as regarding the progress of the E-CLIP; and
8. Coordinate and monitor the E-CLIP implementation in the Province.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All prior issuances on the organization and functions of the E-CLIP Committee inconsistent herein shall be deemed superseded by this Order.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
