Executive Order No. 055

**AN ORDER THE REORGANIZING THE
ENHANCED COMPREHENSIVE LOCAL INTEGRATION PROGRAM COMMITTEE
(E-CLIP)**

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall promote the welfare of all its constituents and declares that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and, the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessing of democracy;

WHEREAS, paragraph VIII-F of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG - Department of National Defense (DND) Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01 dated July 5, 2018, mandates the creation of the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP) Committee at the Provincial Level;

WHEREAS, the E-CLIP in partnership with the local government (Province) provides financial/livelihood assistance to qualified former rebels and mainstreams them as productive citizens and partners in local development;

NOW, THEREFORE, I GERARD ROGER M. ESPINA, Governor of the Province of Biliran, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order to reorganize the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP) Committee of the Province of Biliran;

Section 1. Organization and Composition of the Enhanced. Comprehensive Local Integration Program Committee. The Enhanced Comprehensive is hereby organized and to be constituted as follows:

Section 2. Functions of the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program Committee. Pursuant to DILG-DND Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01, the E-CLIP shall have the following functions:

1. Ensure the convergent effort in the delivery of identified services of the program;
2. Ensure proper documentation and referral of the needs of the Former Rebels (FRs) to appropriate agencies and other partners institutions including getting the profile of FRs;
3. Facilitate the profiling of FRs, through the Local Social Welfare and Development Office(LSWDO);
4. Assist the FR in completing the E-CLIP Enrollment Form. The FR should either sign or thumb mark the Form after completing it attested by DILG Provincial Director and approved by the Provincial Governor or by his designated officer preferably the Provincial Administrator or LSWD Officer;


5. Assist the FR in the preparation of his/her Former Rebel Reintegration Plan (FRRP) and Business Plan, with LSWDO as the lead agency to assist the FR. It shall have the option to come up with its template (form) of FRRP and Business Plan.
6. Resolve issues and concerns affecting the implementation of the E-CLIP;
7. Provide the updates to Provincial Peace and Order Council during its meetings as regarding the progress of the E-CLIP; and

Section 3. Funding. All expenses incurred during various meetings and activities are charge to the Peace and Order Council funds and other available funds of the Provincial Local Government Unit.

Section 4. Repealing Clause. All prior issuances on the organization and functions of the E-CLIP Committee consistent herein shall be deemed superseded by this Order.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
